TOUR COST

The tour cost for 2-days of touring in Savannah is **\$200 per person**, based on 30 participants. A contract with a local charter bus company for a 40-passenger bus has been finalized. The tour cost includes tour fees for all venues/events, motor coach bus rental for the tour on Saturday and Sunday, lunch on Saturday and Sunday, a map/relevant facts booklet, snacks and water while on the bus, and meals/gratuities for bus driver. Participants should make their own travel plans to get to Savannah for the tour.

HOTEL

The hotel is 4 miles from the historic district and includes a hot breakfast each morning. A block of 20 rooms (king room or 2 queen room) has been reserved for Friday, Saturday, and Sunday nights. An additional block of 15 rooms has been reserved for Thursday night. The group code C-MRR should be used to secure this block rate – either online or by calling the hotel directly. The block rate is good through October 7, 2019. **The rate is \$129 per night.**

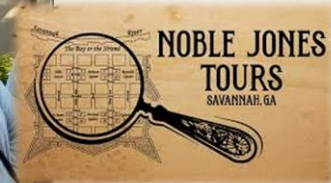
